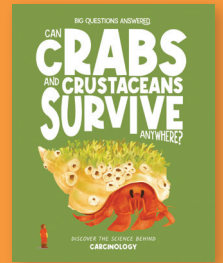
The underwater robotic camera is trying to navigate to find new crabs to study. Can you help the camera find the crab?

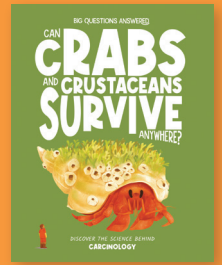

4. You can't use any other letters from the alphabet.

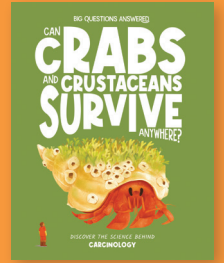

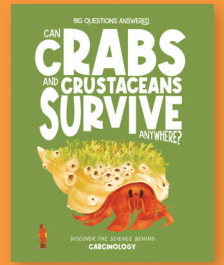
INCREDIBLE COCONUT CRABS

Coconut crabs are the largest species of crustacean on land! Below is an illustration of one – get creative and complete the drawing! Finish the picture by coloring it in.



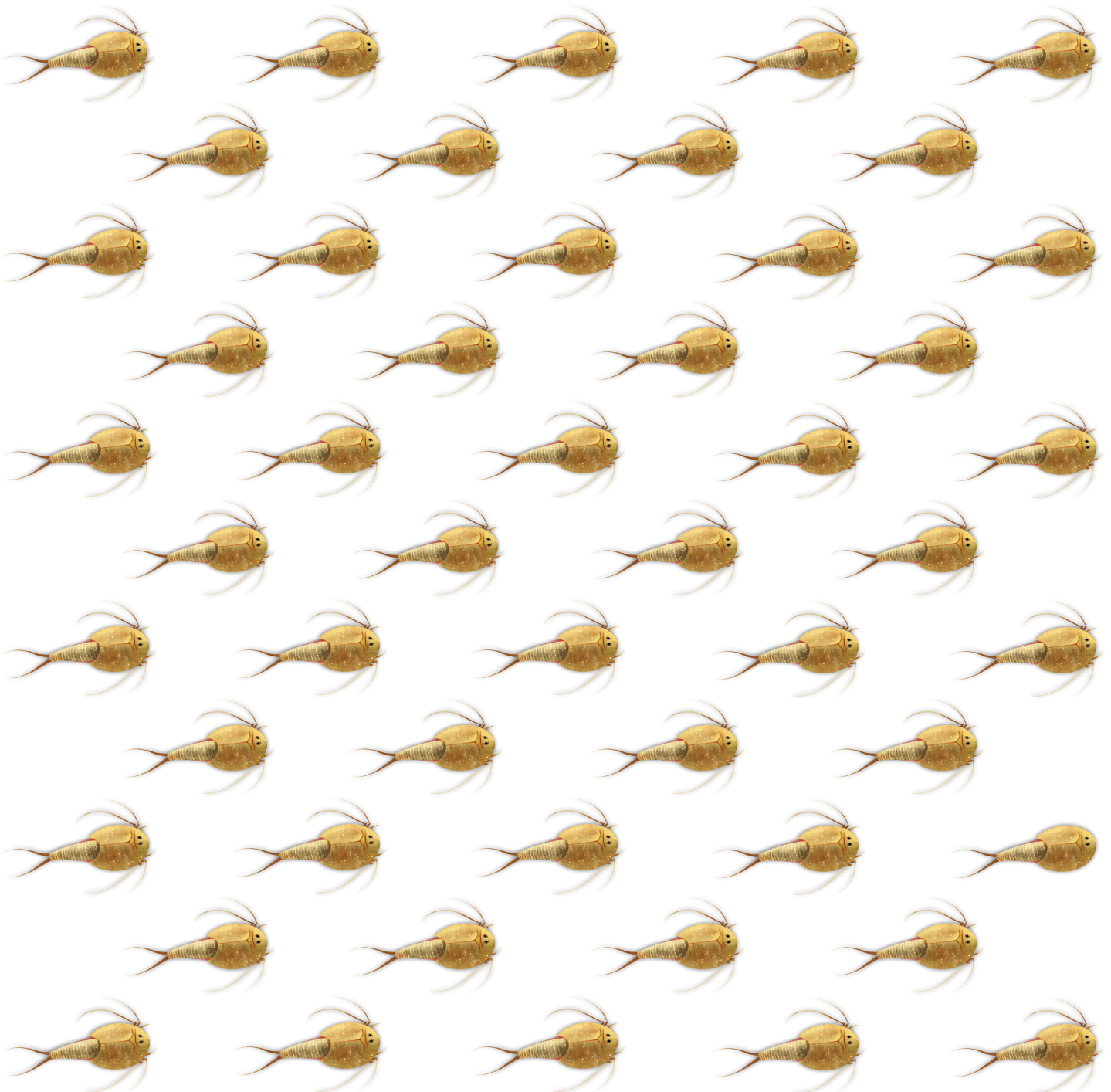

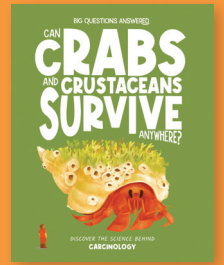
A TRIP TO THE BEACH

The red crab is trying to reach the beach at the edge of the rainforest to lay its eggs! Can you help the crab get to the beach?



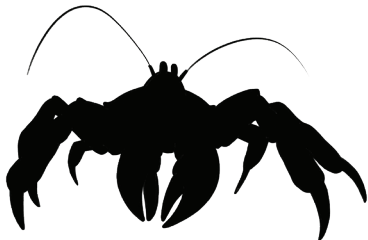
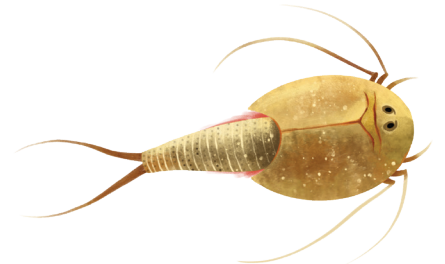
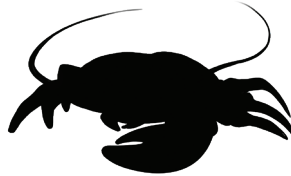
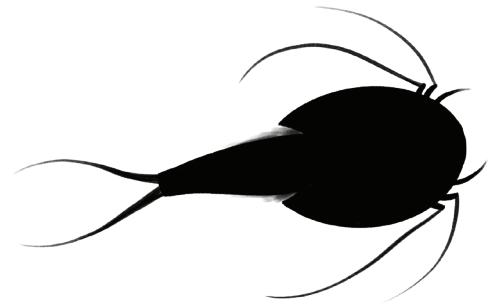
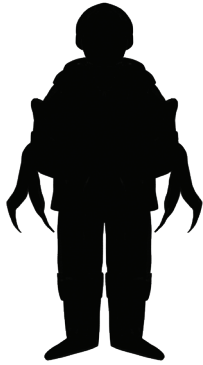

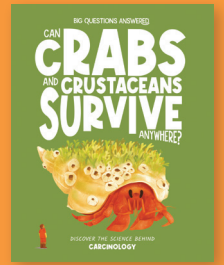
